## Day 1 Singapore – Sao Paulo

*(Meals onboard)*

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport for your flight to Sao Paulo, capital of Brazil. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel.

## Day 2 Sao Paulo

*(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)*

Today, visit **Ibirapuera Park**, to see the **Bandeiras monument** and learn about the history of the bandeirantes, who from the 16th century, penetrated the interior of the American continent. We then cross the famous **Paulista Avenue** to see the imposing Copan and Italia buildings, the Anhangabaú Valley, the **Teatro Municipal** and **Pátio do Colégio** place where the city was founded. Next to The São Bento Monastery and the magnificent Metropolitan Cathedral located at Praça da Sé and appreciate the Pinacoteca Museum and stop to visit **Municipal Market**

## Day 3 Sao Paulo – Puerto Iguazu

*(Breakfast/Dinner)*

Fly from Sao Paulo to Iguazu. Begin the excursion to the **Brazilian Falls** upon arrival. These falls are shaped in a semicircle, is 2700m wide. The extension of the walkways is 1,200 meters from where you get a spectacular view of the 275 falls that make up the Iguazu Falls.

## Day 4 Iguazu Falls

*(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)*

Departure to visit the **Iguazu Falls on the Argentine side**. Entering through the visitors' center, there are several hikes in the jungle to admire the giants of this green world, the jungle that gives us its aromas, its colors, its freshness, a unique contact with variety of plants and animals which is increasingly rare in the modern world. A ride on the narrow-gauge train is a service that connects the 3 different circuits or footbridges of the National Park; lower, upper and devil's throat. You can also combine hikes with optional rides.

## Day 5 Puerto Iguazu – Buenos Aires

*(Breakfast/Dinner)*

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight to Buenos Aires. Upon arrival, transfer to Buenos Aires hotel.

## Day 6 Buenos Aires

*(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)*

Known as "Paris of the Americas", we will visit **Plaza de Mayo** is a city square & main foundational site of Buenos Aires. The oldest residential neighborhood **San Telmo**. Live and feel the original Tango in the neighborhood of **La Boca**, walk along **Caminito Street** and have a chance to witness the dancers perform. Continue to **Recoleta Cemetery** the final resting place of the nation's iconic first lady, Eva Duarte "Evita". Tonight, we will bring to **Dinner & Tango Show**, the most unique and famous show in Argentina

## Day 7 Buenos Aires – Santiago

*(Breakfast)*

Transfer to the airport for your flight to Santiago. Check in hotel and you will receive a welcome letter for your upcoming Antarctica Expedition Cruise.

## Day 8 Santiago – Puerto Williams

*(Breakfast)*

Fly to Puerto Williams for embarkation, begin your adventure expedition cruise trip.

## Day 9-10 Drake Passage

The Drake Passage has a notorious reputation for its turbulent seas due to the westerly winds and the funneling effect of the passage. The Antarctic Convergence, a natural boundary where cold polar water flows northward and warmer equatorial water moves southward, is within the Drake Passage.

## Day 11 Antarctic Sound

The Antarctic Sound is a stretch of water named after the first ship to have passed through this body of water from the Bransfield Strait to the Weddell Sea in 1902. The Sound's





main attractions are the spectacular tabular icebergs that come from the Larsen Ice Shelf further south. Witness cathedral-sized icebergs up close, and blue-hued glaciers, slowly slipping from imposing locations like Hope Bay. Blanched mountain peaks cover the peninsula, and you'll find thousands of adorable Adelie penguin pairs thriving undisturbed in this peninsula's unique setting.

### Day 12-14 Antarctic Peninsula

The main peninsula closest to South America – has a human history of almost 200 years, with explorers, sealers, whalers, and scientists who have come to work, and eventually intrepid visitors coming to enjoy this pristine and remote wilderness. Just as irresistible are the many Gentoo and Chinstrap Penguin colonies, the seals basking on ice floes, the whales and orcas.

*Note: This cruise required to hop on/off into zodiac/ hiking, is recommended for those with a good level of fitness.*

### Day 15 South Shetland Islands

Several countries maintain research bases here, and with plump elephant seals, and crowds of Gentoo, Chinstrap and Adelie Penguins also calling the islands home, it can even feel a little crowded at times. King George Island is the largest and most hospitable island, hosting the majority of the research stations.

Enjoy a full day tour, explore the colorful houses and historic port of **Valparaiso**, a UNESCO World Heritage site; Revel in the vibrant color and culture of Valparaiso Port and take the coastal highway to the modern seaside city of **Viña del Mar**. Next to **Casablanca Valley**, you have chance to test 1-2 wines as this is one of the country's prime growing areas for Chardonnay, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Sauvignon Blanc, and Primus before heading back to Santiago.

### Day 20 Santiago - Rio de Janeiro

*(Breakfast/Dinner)*

Taking flight to 2<sup>nd</sup> largest economy of Brazil - Rio de Janeiro. Transfer to your hotel, stay near the world-famous Copacabana beach.

### Day 21 Rio de Janeiro

*(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)*

This morning, start with a visit to **Corcovado Mountain**, you will get an up-close view of one of the Modern World Wonder, **Christ the Redeemer** and panoramic view of Rio.

After which we will head towards the the **Maracana Stadium** and **Sambodromo**, site of Rios's famous Carnival parade. After lunch, discover the world-famous **Sugarloaf Mountain**, take the cable car to the top, which rises 395 meters above sea level where the view of downtown Rio and the Atlantic are spectacular.

Today, you can do some last-minute shopping before you transfer to the airport for your flight home at night.
